NorthLink 40 – Race Report

What perfect conditions for a time trial, cool and almost zero breeze at least that's how it was at the start/finish area. Seven people agreed by setting new PBs, Christine Golder the most impressive with an improvement of 18:40 over her previous best. Most importantly the riders who called back to the finish all seemed positive about their ride and commented what a good morning it had been. Thanks to the WCMCC riders who joined us today, you are always welcome to participate in our events.

Quickest rider today was Sean Ralph (current holder on the Male Road Bike Course Record) this time on his new TT bike and also setting a new PB for himself. Fastest female rider was Rachael Smyth, her previous rides on this course were 80k events so no baseline to compare too. Irina Baimatova established a new Female Road Bike Course Record, shaving 1:54 off the previous record time.

Congratulations to our 2 Junior riders today, Ava Rodgers and Danny Barton who are both 14 years old. Great results considering they were riding bikes with restricted gearing as required by AusCycling for their age groups. Also an outstanding effort by Ian Davies who was the oldest rider in the field.

We had several riders who were late arriving at the start. It doesn't help your overall time if the clock is running and you are yet to begin. Please ensure you allow sufficient time to make it to the start in advance of your allocated time and yes, for those who prefer a long warmup it nearly always takes longer than you plan to ride to Ellenbrook no matter what the conditions.

Managing the desk at the school was Jarred Anderson and Allan Cooper greeted riders at the northern U-turn. David Equid handled the start list preparation, was starter and ran the timing systems. Mouse provided his usual results validation and updating the historical records.

Unfortunately we had some issues with the timing system at the Muchea U-turn so not everyone had a time recorded. Apologies to those who missed out, hopefully you have sufficient information available from your bike GPS unit.

Our next event is back at NorthLink in 3 weeks time for the 160k Championship. We also offer 40k and 80k options for those who aren't keen on the longest distance.
